HOUSE BILL NO. _____

A bill to prohibit municipalities from requiring an individual to wear a face covering on public or private property or in a public or private building; to provide for the powers and duties of certain local governmental officers and entities; and to provide that certain local ordinances, resolutions, or policies are void and unenforceable.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Face covering" includes, but is not limited to, a face



1 mask, face shield, or respirator used to cover an individual's nose
2 and mouth for sanitary purposes.

3 (b) "Governing body" means the body in which the legislative
4 powers of a municipality are vested.

5 (c) "Municipality" means a county, city, village, or township.

6 Sec. 3. Beginning on the effective date of this act, the
7 governing body of a municipality shall not adopt or enforce an
8 ordinance, resolution, or policy that requires an individual to
9 wear a face covering on public or private property or in a public
10 or private building.

11 Sec. 5. Any provision in an ordinance, resolution, or policy
12 adopted by the governing body of a municipality on or after the
13 effective date of this act that violates section 3 is void and
14 unenforceable.
