

Facts and FALSEHOODS About the Michigan Ballot Proposals

Proposal 1: Let Lansing politicians serve 6 terms in House instead of 3

Misleading Claim: “This will shorten term limits for state lawmakers.”

Facts: *Most Lansing lawmakers never serve in the Senate* (because there are only 38 Senate seats and 110 House seats). For most Lansing politicians this will double their term in office. The proposal was put on the ballot by Lansing lawmakers to protect their own jobs.

Proposal 2: Dismantle the remaining safeguards against election fraud

Falsehood: “This will protect your right to vote.”

Facts: Vote fraud *disenfranchises everyone who casts a ballot lawfully*, and Proposal 2 would: 1) Prohibit requiring ID to vote; 2) Legalize ballot harvesting, whereby political operatives deliver absentee ballots in bulk. Nothing could prevent them from steaming open the envelopes and replacing them with counterfeit ballots (ballots have no security features) or throwing them away; 3) Allow private corporations to fund electioneering operations under color of government; 4) Require polls be open for at least 10 days; making citizen oversight impossible; 5) Dismantle the audit process by prohibiting opposing sides from participating and ensuring the process is fair.

Proposal 3: Legalize all abortion and child sexual self-mutilation

Falsehood: “This will keep Michigan’s abortion law the same as it was.”

Facts: Michigan law does *not* allow for late-term or dismemberment abortions, but under this proposal the Michigan Constitution would legalize all forms of the most barbaric late-term abortion, up to the moment of birth, if in the sole discretion of the abortionist it’s needed for the mother’s “mental health.”

Even more extreme: *the amendment would create an “individual right” – with no minimum age – to “all matters relating to pregnancy,” including “sterilization” and presumably sex.*
